Topic: *Ladder Safety*

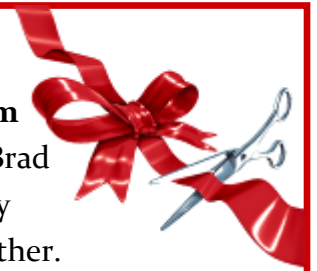
