We hear it all the time that there are no jobs in Coshocton. Well that is just not the case and is very untrue. At the recent Employment Expo hosted by Ohio Means Jobs –Coshocton County there were sixty two employers set up and ready to do on-spot interviews. Over 250 job seekers came through the doors. The official breakdown to date is that 382 resumes were submitted, 233 applications were received, 67 interviews were conducted and so far 26 job offers were made that day. One of the successes for the event is that the Career Center, Opportunity School and local high schools all had students attend and ready to interview for potential jobs. New hires continue to be reported each week since the event. So the bottom line is when people say to you that there are no jobs in Coshocton, please let them know that is just not the case.

On another note that leads to future employment, the Chamber office is busy working on Manufacturing Day 2019. This premier event will take place Friday, October 11th with four local manufacturing companies opening their doors to area juniors and seniors. We look forward to arming the students with timely information from our partners at Central Ohio Technical College for the Coshocton Promise and the ACTtT classes. The Coshocton Port Authority and Ohio Means Jobs-Coshocton County are also partners for this day. Then at the end of the month, we will be hosting the Healthcare/First Responders Day. Again, working with area schools and preparing students that are interested in these career fields to highlight what is available locally is key to getting students to come back to Coshocton County to live and work.

As we kick off the month of October remember to make your way out to the 168th Coshocton County Fair. Take some time to enjoy Apple Butter Stir and the Farm Foliage Tour. We are so blessed with beauty all around us.






